All texts are required unless otherwise stated. Local sources for purchasing textbooks include UDC Follett Bookstore, campus bookstores at other law schools, and fellow law students. On-line sources include Amazon.com, LawBooksForLess.com, BarristerBooks.com, AbeBooks.com, Chegg.com, publishers' websites, etc. Always double-check that you are getting the correct edition required by the professor. The Higher Education Opportunity Act requires schools to provide the publisher's suggested retail price (PSRP) for new textbooks, but UDC Law does not require students to purchase new textbooks. Students may buy used books, borrow, rent, etc., as long as they are able to get the required edition of each text. Students should not purchase E-books unless expressly permitted by the professor. Even when E-books are allowed, hard copies are recommended.
