About the Fall 2021 Course Schedule and Operating Modes

Courses with in-person instruction (IP/HY): Except for certain sections of 1L Lab and Lawyering Process I, all courses with in-person instruction are **hybrid**, meaning students decide whether to attend in-person or remotely (assuming the student has been cleared to be on campus; see below). Once you pick a mode for a hybrid course, please stick with that mode for the entire semester. The professor may require students to declare a mode for a hybrid course. Courses with in-person instruction will have a teaching assistant present to facilitate communication between remote students and the professor during class.

Courses with remote instruction (REM): Students must attend remote courses online when scheduled; attendance policies will be enforced. You may participate in a remote course from any location. Each remote course will have its own “parallel” classroom solely for students who prefer to be in the building while participating in that remote course (see next page). The expectation is that students in parallel classrooms will use their own laptops with headphones.

1L Lab and Lawyering Process I: Students assigned to sections of 1L Lab and/or LP I with in-person instruction must attend those sections in-person (i.e., the in-person sections are not hybrid). Those students may use the classroom 515/516 to remotely attend Civil Procedure I prior to attending in-person 1L Lab and/or LP I. Students in remote sections of 1L Lab and/or LP I may participate from any location; those who would prefer to be in the building may use the parallel classroom for their section.

General Health & Safety Information:

- Due to COVID-19, all students, faculty, and staff must be cleared by University Health Services before entering campus.
