**Clinic I tutorial is generally a two-hour class. The third hour of clinic is a flexible hour to be used at the discretion of the clinical faculty for case rounds, additional class time, or other clinical purposes. For Housing Clinic only: The required tutorial session for daytime (7-credit) Housing Clinic meets Monday evenings from 6:00-8:00 at the RFJ office downtown; other than the tutorial session, the 7-credit Housing Clinic is a daytime clinic.

***Beginning Fall 2023, all students must satisfactorily complete at least 4 credits of Property. Satisfactory completion of a required course that awards letter grades is defined as earning a grade of "C-" or above (*Student Handbook*, Section 1.3.1). If you have not taken or must retake Property I (3 credits), you can meet the Property

requirement by satisfactorily completing Property (4 credits) in Fall. If you have satisfactorily completed Property I (3 credits) but have not taken or must retake Property II (3 credits), you can meet the Property requirement by satisfactorily completing Advanced Property in Spring.

***Legal & Bar Success Foundations is a required course intended for 3L Day and 4L Evening students. Adv. Legal Analysis: Bar Exam Multiple Choice is an elective course intended for 2L Day and 3L Evening students.
